

Audio Output Switcher

Here's a quick introduction to the menu and its function.

- **Startup Automatically:** Start Audio Output Switcher automatically when the computer startup.
- **Global Hotkeys:** Use this dialog to customize the hotkeys to easily control many functions of Audio Output switcher. **Note:** if Auto Switch is enabled and the configured application (software application to monitor) is running, it will have control of switching the playback device. During this time, switching between audio playback devices using the global hotkeys or the manual switching method is disabled. It will be in this state until the configured application is closed or the Auto Switch function is turned off.
- **Auto Switch:** Audio Output Switcher can automatically switch to any audio playback device based on some preconfigured settings. This dialog tells Audio Output Switcher which software program it needs to monitor and what audio playback device it needs to switch to. **Note:** when Audio Output Switcher detect that a configured application is currently running, it will take control of the audio playback switching function until that application is closed or the Auto Switch function is turned off.
- **Audio Playback Devices List:** This is a list of all the available playback devices on the computer. The speaker symbol with the green sound wave is the currently selected device. Click on the speaker icon with the red-x will select that playback device.
